About the Scholarship

Selected recipients will receive \$1,250 upon verification - by the B.C. Ministry of Education - that they meet eligibility criteria, are registered with an approved post-secondary education or training provider and are actively attending a program that leads to a recognized credential.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to win the District/Authority scholarship, applicants must:

Meet basic eligibility requirements set by the B.C. Ministry of Education:


- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant) at the time of registration in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded
- □ Be a B.C. resident
- □ Be or have been in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded:
 - Enrolled in a British Columbia public school (including Distributed Learning schools), or
 - Enrolled in a Group 1, 2, or 4 British Columbia Independent School, or
 - Enrolled in a Continuing Education Centre, or
 - Registered with a public, independent, francophone or distributed learning school in B.C. as a homeschooled child

Demonstrate outstanding achievement in any of the following focus areas:

- Indigenous Languages and Culture, demonstrated at school or in the community
- □ Fine Arts (e.g., Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music)
- □ Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (e.g., Business Ed, Technology Ed, Home Economics, Information Communication Technology)
- Physical Activity (e.g., Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, not limited to Physical Education)


