KAMLOOPS CURLING CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by the Kamloops Curling Club through contributions of its members to assist junior curlers with their post secondary education goals.

Criteria:

1. Student must maintain a 'B' average in their chosen course of studies.
2. Student must have participated in junior curling for a minimum of 2 years at the Kamloops Curling Club and must be curling in their Grade 12 year.
3. Student must be continuing education in a post secondary institution in BC.
4. Student must demonstrate commitment and service to the sport of curling.

Amount of the award(s): May vary annually.

Application Procedure:

1. Student to provide a typed letter of application addressing the criteria for the award and outlining:
 - Involvement with the curling club
 - Future goals and objectives
 - Community involvement
 - School involvement
 - Athletic activities
2. Student to provide two only letters of reference supporting the above.
3. Student to provide Supplementary Information Form that includes Grade 11 and Grade 12 marks.
4. Application deadline in May 1st.

Award Procedure:

1. To claim the award, the student will provide proof of acceptance and registration at a post secondary institution in BC (including student #) to:
