It costs money to join - There is no cost to join the program! Each candidate is responsible for finding a sponsor that will cover the costs of your candidacy. This could be a family business, your workplace, your favorite place to shop at, the list goes on! We will help you during the process. We have fantastic local sponsors who love to support our candidates. Cost will never be an obstacle to someone wanting to join the program.

I'm too busy! - This is one we hear a lot. Our classes are once a week (Sunday from 2-4pm) until March/April when we add a Wednesday class (usually 5:30-7:30pm) once we start speech and dance. You'll receive a calendar with scheduled classes, so you will know in advance what is coming up. There are a few community events that we are invited to every year, but we'll give you as much notice as possible, and while we want you to take in as much as you can during your six months, they are not mandatory. As a bonus, we also teach skills like time management and stress management. Making a commitment until July sounds like a long time, but trust us, it goes by so fast! Without fail, no one can believe it when election weekend arrives. Plus, you'll be wishing it wasn't over! Think of this time as an investment in yourself. You are worth it!
